Great reception in Xàtiva of the CAPABILITY-TB Project Presentation Day with a large audience and with the support of the Xàtiva Town Council

On Friday, October 28, COPAVA presented the results of the CAPABILITY-TB project, the training program to improve the inclusion and participation of People with Intellectual Disabilities through a Time Bank.

Fully involved in the organization of the event, professionals and users of the 'Aspromivise La Costera-Canal' Occupational Center took care of every last detail, making the conference a success.

A large number of people gathered in the auditorium of the High School for Professional Studies CIPFP La Costera: teachers, students, family members, professionals from the disability sector, etc. In short, more than 100 people with different profiles were able to find out what CAPABILITY-TB consists of and explore the training materials created for the e-learning platform and the online Bank Time.

The event was opened by the Director of the Aspromivise Occupational Center, Amor Amorós, and the Mayor of Xàtiva Town Hall, Roger Cerdà, who attended accompanied by the Councilor for Social Welfare, Xelo Angulo, representing the municipality.

After presenting the training materials created for the CAPABILITY TB project by the partners of the transnational consortium, the large audience took a tour of the Online Time Bank, designed in an intuitive and accessible way, in an open format, so that anyone can be part of this collaborative community in which services are exchanged and where money is not paid: the currency is the time.

Finally, a group of users from different occupational centers (Francisco Esteve Board of Paterna, Socoltie de Sagunto, El Castellet de Castelló and Aspromivise de Xàtiva), together with professionals from the sector of intellectual disability, shared their experience in the validation sessions of the CAPABILITY-TB course and explained how they had made their first real exchanges in the Time Bank
